







Marvin's Labor Day BBQ Babyback Ribs Recipe



Escape from the Everglades



I loved his *Code of Silence* three-book series, so decided to read the first in his *High Water* series. *Escape from the Everglades*, is much more harrowing than his other novels. Parker, the main character, learns first-hand the dangers of the
