MY NEW FAVORITE VEGGIE RECIPE

Air-Fryer Ranch Broccoli

The slow cooker has always been my go-to kitchen appliance for easy meals, but I'm learning that the air fryer can be just as user friendly. This is one of the recipes I found in the <u>Hungry</u>

Girl email newsletter. I highly recommend subscribing to it.

5 cups (about one 12-oz. bag) fresh broccoli florets 1 tbsp. olive oil 1/2 tsp. ranch dressing/dip seasoning mix

Place broccoli in a large bowl. Add oil, and toss to coat. Sprinkle with ranch seasoning mix, and toss to coat.

Place 2 tbsp. water in the base of an air fryer. (This will prevent smoking.)

Set air fryer to 400°F. Cook until tender on the inside and crisp on the outside, 8–10 minutes.
